--Senator Anthony Portantino's office, Arda Tschakian [arda.tschakian@sen/ca/gov]

SB 14 and 224, authored by the State Senator, were signed into law by the Governor. The bills address the mental health outcomes for California youth. The Governor signed SB 144 into law. This tax incentive program illustrates Senator Portatino's deep commitment and appreciation of the entertainment industry.

Assembly Member Friedman passed many bills, including AB 468 (emotional support animals), AB 1556 (wildfires), AB43 (traffic safety), and AB1556 (ticket sellers refunding money when events cancelled).

Metrics in the county continue to decline; on October 7, the county requires all employees be vaccinated; in July, Barger passed a motion on homelessness; expanded mental health services at schools; designated Tallyrand Restaurant as Small Business of the Year.
